MEDICATION INFORMATION

If your student does NOT have OTC or prescription medication, you may ignore this form.

All medication for Camp Ben Lippen must be turned in by **Friday, August 13** to Christy Lambert at the front desk.

Please note that medication bottles will NOT be returned. If you have any questions, please contact Mrs. Gina Dickinson.

DIRECTIONS:

Place the following inside a **1 GALLON ZIPLOCK BAG:**



- Write the students name and grade on the bag with a Sharpie marker
- BL Medication (attached). This form provides space for 2 medications. Make additional copies if needed.
- Medication (OTC and prescription) in the original container (only enough to cover the trip plus one extra dosage)
- Notify school if student has an EpiPen or rescuer inhaler

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Students may NOT carry prescription or over-the-counter medication on their person.
- The exception are students who have an EpiPen or rescue inhaler. These students are required to carry their EpiPen and rescue inhaler on their person at all times.
- Ben Lippen provides generic Tylenol, Advil, Benadryl, Tums, Hydrocortisone Cream, and Neosporin as needed.
