

# Grades 9-12 Supply List

Please note that some classes may require additional supplies as the year progresses.

## All Students Will Need:

- Binder (3-ring) with notebook paper (dividers recommended)
- Highlighters, Pens (blue, black, and red), Pencils
- Ear buds

## Additional Needs for Specific Courses:

- **Bible** - Bible for all grades 9-12 (ESV)
  - **Freshmen/Sophomores:** Students should bring whatever coloring medium they prefer (colored pencils, markers, or crayons) for their "Bible Charts".
- **English** - One composition journal for all levels
  - **English Fundamentals (Honors and CP):** 1" loose-leaf binder and paper dedicated to English Fundamentals and 1 composition journal
- **Fine Arts** – All performance classes, students will be required to purchase formal attire. Instructions will be communicated to families during the first week of school.
  - **Guitar I, II, and III:** Heavy duty black 1" 3-ring binder dedicated to Guitar
  - **Band:** Black 1" 3-ring binder with page protectors
  - **Drawing, 2D Art, & 3D Art:** 9x12 sketchbook with 60+ pages
- **History** -
  - **AP United States Government and Politics:** AP US Government & Politics Review Book recommended by the teacher (needed *first* semester)
  - **Government (All levels):** 3-ring binder dedicated to Government class.
  - **World History (CP & Honors):** Spiral notebook for notes
  - **AP European History:** 3-ring binder dedicated to AP Euro., and the AP European History Review Book recommended by the teacher (needed during second semester)
  - **World Cultures (CP, Honors, & AP):** (1) 1" or 1.5" 3-ring binder dedicated to World Cultures, loose leaf paper (Cornell notes format preferred or regular), tabbed dividers (enough for 10 tabbed sections), sheet protectors, colored pencils, fine point pen. AP Human Geography Review Book recommended by the teacher (*AP Human Geography Only*).
- **Math** – Graph paper for all levels
  - **Algebra 1:** 3-ring binder or spiral notebook, calculator.
  - **Algebra 2:** TI-84 or equivalent graphing calculator. 3-ring binder
  - **Statistics (CP):** TI-84 or equivalent graphing calculator. 3-ring binder or spiral notebook with pockets.
  - **AP Statistics:** TI-84 or equivalent, College Board approved, graphing calculator. AP Statistics review book recommended by the teacher.
  - **Geometry :** TI-84 or equivalent graphing calculator. Graph paper, 3-ring binder, grid paper composition book, ruler, compass, protractor, individual pen-sized dry erased marker
  - **Trigonometry/Discrete Math:** 3-ring binder
  - **AP Calculus:** TI-84 or equivalent, College Board approved, graphing calculator. AP Calculus review book recommended by the teacher.
- **Science** - All grades 9-12 science courses require a dedicated 3-ring binder.
  - **Anatomy & Physiology:** Colored pencils (at least 24 count) and a pack of index cards
  - **Biology (CP and Honors):** Colored pencils (at least 24 count) and a pack of index cards
  - **Environmental & Marine Science:** Colored pencils (at least 24 count) and a pack of index cards
  - **AP Biology :** AP Biology Review Book recommended by the teacher.
  - **Chemistry (CP & Honors):** TI-83 or TI-84 calculator, composition notebook, and a notebook
  - **AP Chemistry:** TI-83 or TI-84 calculator, Composition notebook, and a notebook. AP Chemistry Review book recommended by the teacher.
  - **Physics (Honors & AP):** TI-84 or equivalent, College Board approved, graphing calculator, and notebook
- **World Languages** –
  - **Spanish 1:** 3-ring binder, loose-leaf paper, pack of index cards
  - **Spanish 2 & 3:** Spanish/English Dictionary, 1 composition notebook, red pens, black or blue pens, highlighters, wide-rule paper.
  - **French 1, 2, & 3:** Binder to organize notes
